

## Risk Levels for HUCs in Luzon as of February 14, 2022

Angeles, Dagupan, Lucena and Olongapo improved to low risk, while Baguio City, Puerto Princesa, Naga City and Santiago were at moderate risk. Cases continue to trend downward with negative growth rates and low reproduction numbers. The public is advised to continue to observe minimum public health standards.
