

NCR and Calabarzon at low risk

The positivity rates and ADAR (average daily attack rate) in the NCR and Calabarzon continued to decrease as all provinces had less than 10% positivity rate as of February 15. NCR, Batangas, Cavite, Laguna, Quezon and Rizal are now classified as low risk. In the NCR, the ADAR decreased to 3.45, while the reproduction number remained very low at 0.20, the positivity rate decreased to 6% and the healthcare utilization rate remained very low at 26%.
