



NCR, Calabarzon, Central Luzon Risk Levels as of March 8, 2022

Aurora, Bulacan, Laguna, Pampanga, Quezon, Rizal and Zambales at VERY LOW RISK while NCR, Bataan, Batangas, Cavite, Nueva Ecija and Tarlac remained at LOW RISK. NCR is now averaging 198 new cases per day from March 2 to 8, 2022 with a reproduction number of 0.24, positivity rate of 3%, Covid healthcare utilization rate of 23%, Covid ICU utilization of 25% and ADAR of 1.40 per 100k per day.
